- * Add \$25 to the entry fee to compete in both gross and net divisions
- * **Registration OPENS on Tuesday, May 12th at 10:00AM**
- * Registration ENDS on Sunday, May 31st at 6:00PM
- * Registration and payment may be done online via a link that will be emailed on Tuesday, May 12th. Applications may also be found on our tournament partner's website, the Philadelphia Publinks, and mailed directly to them.

- * All players will receive a sleeve of Golf Balls of their choice
- * Gift cards for pro shop merchandise will be awarded to the top finishers in each flight

Eligibility: Registration is open to amateur golfers, regardless of handicap and club affiliation. To be eligible to compete in senior divisions, player must meet the minimum age requirement before the tournament date.



- * Senior Division (50 - 59 years of age)



- * Super-Senior Division (60 - 69 years of age)



- * Legends Division (70 years of age and older)

There is also a net division and the May 31st handicap revision will be used for this championship.

Pairings: Pairings will be comprised of "threesomes" or "foursomes"

- * Saturday's play will begin at 7:00AM with tee times off the 1st tee
- * Contestants will be notified by email when pairings are available on the PPGA website: www.phillypublinks.com
- * Players will be flighted and repaired for the final round.

Competition: 36-Hole individual stroke play event contested over 2 days

- * Saturday's round will also serve as the qualifying round for flights
- * Players will compete for prizes within their division and flights for the final round and play will begin with tee times at 7:00AM for Sunday as well.
- * Ties will be broken by a sudden-death playoff for the overall champion in each division ONLY starting on the 1st hole. All other ties will be broken using the USGA tie-breaking format.
